

## Checklist

It is essential that you learn to read critically, rather than simply accepting everything in the textbook. This involves such things as determining whether information is fact or opinion, and identifying the writer's purpose. In order to read critically:



Have you checked the tenses, especially the past tense?

Referencing	Have you used citations in the text, showing where you got ideas and/or information
	from other writers?
	Have you put a list at the end (References) giving all your sources?
	Have you paid attention to your tutor's specific instructions concerning the bibliography?
Word Count	Have you checked the word count against the assignment instructions?
